To our Campground Seasonal Guests,

MBC will open our seasonal campground sites this Saturday, May 16th, consistent with the Provincial guidelines announced today. The campground gates will open at 8 AM on Saturday. We look forward to welcoming your family back to MBC!

Due to freezing temperatures in the last week we were unable to turn on our water system until May 13th. Water will be on at your trailer, but we will have a **boil water advisory** in place until lab tests are received confirming that the water is safe to drink. You must use boiled water or an alternate source of safe drinking water (such as bottled water) for:

- drinking
- making ice cubes, juices or other mixes
- preparing baby food or infant formula
- food preparation, including washing fruits and vegetables
- gargling or brushing teeth or dentures

Bring water to a rolling boil for at least one minute. Let water cool before using or drinking. Flush water through your hose and tap thoroughly before connecting it to your trailer.

For the safety of guests and staff, and to comply with provincial COVID-19 regulations, the following measures are in place. We will keep you updated as measures change over the course of the season:

Electronic waivers:

- Each seasonal trailer owner is required to fill out an electronic waiver, acknowledging the risks and safety protocols associated with COVID-19
- If you rent your trailer, you must email us (campground@muskokabible.com) with names, email address and cell phone number of anyone using the trailer other than the registered owner and their immediate family. This is required for tracing purposes in the event of an occurrence of COVID-19 on the grounds. Each renter or visitor must also fill out an electronic waiver.
- Please follow this link to the waiver and fill it out prior to travelling to MBC. We reserve the right to refuse access until we have a completed waiver on file.

The following areas are closed at this time, to comply with provincial restrictions:

- Nightly camp sites
- Public washrooms
- The Lodge, Dining Room, Hub, Chapel and Bookstore
- The beach area
- Playgrounds at the gym, beach and campground
- We will not be able to hold a chapel service this weekend

Restrictions on gathering:

- The rules regarding gathering that apply at your home will also apply at your trailer – no visitors, one family only on the trailer site.
- Campfires are currently prohibited by the municipality and the province
- You are welcome to walk anywhere on the grounds, but please observe 6-foot distancing guidelines as you meet your friends and neighbours in your travels. Please also be aware of the 6-foot guideline in wifi hot spots.

The following areas are open at this time:

- The Nibble Nook is open by appointment to make payments and to facilitate the process of trailers being purchased, sold or moved. Call 705-789-0123 ext 233 to reach campground staff.
- We expect the Nibble Nook will open for retail sales in the coming week. Limitations will be in place on the number of guests in the store at a given time.
- Marina boat slips, boat ramp and storage yard are open. Contact the Nibble Nook staff to book your boat slip. Most, but not all docks are in the water at this time. The Nibble Nook staff can assist you if your dock is not yet ready.
- The laundry area is open. We ask that you wear a face mask in the laundry area and thoroughly wash your hands before and after using the laundry machines.
- Due to the provincial activity restrictions that have been in place, we have not been able to get our grounds and facilities up to our usual standards for this time of the year. We appreciate your patience as we work to catch up!

We are excited to be able to open the seasonal Campground, and we are looking forward to opening other areas of MBC as provincial restrictions allow. We are praying that God will provide for a safe and fruitful season of Ministry at MBC. We look forward to seeing your family soon!
