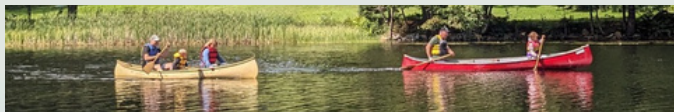

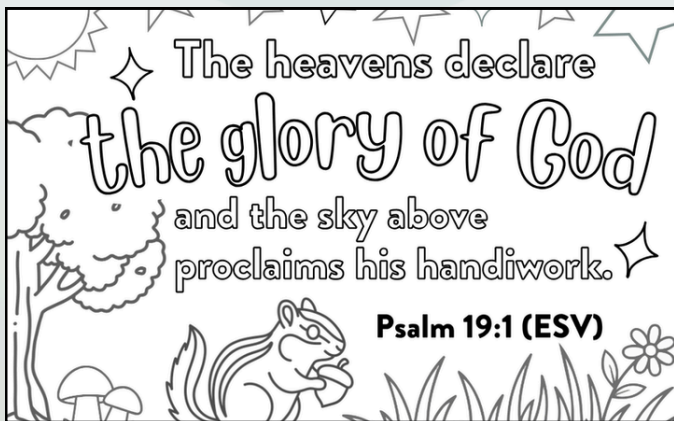

SALT & LITE

As Widjiitiwin campers and MBC youth grow, we want to help develop them into young leaders who will change the world. Our SALT (Skills and Leadership Training) program is an open enrollment 4-week course for youth ages 14-16 who are interested in developing the skills needed for working at camp, other departments at MBC and in life. Our LITE (Leaders in Training Experience) Program is designed to give your teenager a taste of what the full SALT Program is all about, in only 2 weeks!



Program Highlights:

- **Discipleship:** Daily devotional time, Bible studies, prayer partners and group prayer, community worship, guest speakers, testimonies, and discussions about what the Bible has to say about a wide range of issues.
- **Adventure:** LITE goes for one overnight to Widjiitiwin Island; SALT goes for one overnight to Widjiitiwin Island as well as a four-day canoe trip.
- **Education:** SALT participants can elect to work towards an Ontario Grade 11 Healthy Active Living Education credit (PAD30).
